WASHINGTON — Today, the Democratic Legislative Campaign Committee announced the addition of three new members to the DLCC Board of Directors. North Carolina House Democratic Leader Robert Reives, California Senator Monique Limón, and Iowa House Democratic Leader Jennifer Konfrst will join the DLCC Board of Directors ahead of the most important election cycle in state legislative campaign history.

Drawn from legislative leaders across the country, the DLCC's board is the national governing body of the committee.

Among other responsibilities, the DLCC's board members:

- Provide strategic thought partnership around DLCC's strategy and goals.
- Review organizational performance.
- Represent DLCC and its mission within the party to the media and donors.
- Provide tangible examples of the critical work that Democratic leadership is doing in states.

Most importantly, the DLCC board is integral to driving Democrats' nationwide strategy to win elections in state legislatures. These new board members bring expertise from across the country – their insights will help us reach every community and build Democratic power in 2024 and beyond. The DLCC is poised to make this year our most successful year yet in winning state legislatures.

Leader Robert Reives was elected to the North Carolina House in 2014. As a former prosecutor and a current attorney, Robert has a clear eye toward protecting those who are marginalized, vulnerable, and oppressed. That same approach informs how he leads as a state representative. Robert immediately took on leadership roles upon entering the General Assembly, and he was elected to serve as the House Democratic Leader in 2020.

Senator Monique Limón was elected to the California Senate in November 2020. Born and raised in the 19th Senate District, Monique has worked continuously to serve the community she now represents as an educator, leader, and advocate for causes advancing the quality of life in her community. Before joining the Senate, Monique served for four years as the assemblymember for the region.

Leader Jennifer Konfrst is serving her third term in the Iowa House of Representatives. She served as the House Minority Whip during the 2021 legislative session after which she was elected as the House Democratic Leader, becoming the first woman to hold the post. Her work in the legislature focuses on public education, health care, workers' rights, affordable housing, and supporting families.


Chair Andrea Stewart-Cousins issued the following statement:
